Google Classroom is available to Educational institutions with the Google Apps for Education. At MySchool it is available for all their teachers.

By using Google Classroom in my class, it enforces the 'going paperless' vision at MySchool. Students do not have to worry about misplacing sheets of papers. It designates a place for the teacher to post assignments and provide resources without the use of paper. It saves time for the teacher to post important information in once place, such as announcements, practice assignments, extra exercises, and short questions.

In fact, using Google Classroom allows for learning to continue outside of the classroom, it probes the student to dig deeper into their previous knowledge and build new topic knowledge. With Google Classroom, learning material is posted in the form of educational videos and articles. Students can view, post comments, and reply to their classmate's comments. It also allows students to be engaged with questions and answers. Students develop critical thinking when

sharing their ideas and opinions, which happens with collaboration and communication inside and outside the classroom.

Furthermore, I have found that using Google Classroom with my students has allowed me to stay organized; helps me stay in tune with my students as they learn a new topic; and at the same time it is a way to assess my student's knowledge as we progress in the units in the book. I award points to students who put effort in learning, this will positively encourage my students to use Google Classroom. These extra points will add up at the end and will help students raise their grade.

Indeed, support and encouragement are required from the parents at home. Parents should understand the benefits for their child when using Google Classroom. Most importantly, supervision should be practiced at home when their child is using the internet.

My hope is for every student to be actively using Google Classroom. With the collaboration and cooperation between parents and teacher the benefits of Google Classroom will have a tremendous impact in their child's education.




