

Mathematics Department

For this Academic year 2016/2017, it was decided to have two new departments with their own Head of Department. I head up the Mathematics Department which I refer to as Team Mathematics. These are a team of dedicated teachers who have joined MySchool to bring something new and exciting to the Math's classroom.

The vision of our department is to improve the standards of Maths in the school and provide opportunities for students to explore their full Mathematical potential. My belief is that everyone can do Maths, albeit simple addition or subtraction. Relevance in this modern age of technology where computers, smart phones and tablets do all the work for one makes the learning process stagnate and children don't utilize their abilities as much. As stakeholders in their education we need to provide relevance for them. Simple exercises or games like adding up the goods in the basket at the shop, which box is bigger or smaller, which meal is the cheapest on the menu, or simply letting them work out how much money is needed to pay the bill at the till and the change that they should receive. Let us provide relevance for our students in everyday activities and maths will come alive and stimulate their interest.

In addition to the Oxford International Mathematics textbook, we have introduced a new workbook that further consolidates the work done in the classroom with extra examples. We have also purchased the MyMaths and Myimaths programs to further assist the students to truly reach their potential. My years of working in Tertiary Education in Oman has frustrated me to see how students were frustrated

with maths and simply lacked the skills to complete simple tasks. I am happy to be at the grassroots level making sure that our students will have the foundation to attempt anything that they encounter. I am confident that the Team hired to achieve this will produce the results we are hoping for.



As we transition towards the PYP system of Education, be

assured that the foundation and building blocks of Maths will be established and the learning cycles and approaches of the PYP explored. I think this is an exciting time for our new generation – I ask that before we criticize let us explore options together and find ways to make this all culminate in our students being the best. With the new system of Education, the exponential growth in the size of the school, keeping tabs on what is happening in Maths requires constant monitoring hence the need for a Head of Department. Monitoring and mentoring are key words I like to use when dealing with teachers and students alike. The benefit is that not one will slip through the system and not be assisted. The gifted students will be extended and the remedial students assisted to ensure that they are not left behind. I have a simple request for parents to assist us in making sure that your child knows their Multiplication tables and that homework is completed every day. In association with the OXford University Press, on the 5th & 6th of October 2016, MySchool English teachers have participated in a two-days workshop about the teaching techniques and strategies of a guided reading programme. In our case, the

programme that we purchased and which will be used in all our KG and grade levels is the Oxford Reading Tree / Floppy's Phonics.

During the training sessions, the teachers became familiar with all the resources used in the programme (the levelled books, the teaching guides, posters, flashcards, the interactive CD, the assessment pack...) as well as they participated in an interactive teaching experience using the materials provided, then they contributed in an interesting discussion about the techniques they applied. My Body and the Skeleton

The Grade 4 classes began the New Academic Year by exploring the miraculous composition of the human body. They have learnt how the body can easily be infected by germs and viruses and have gained an understanding on the importance of maintaining good health to fight off illnesses. They are also learning about the different systems in the body which lead to a well functioned body. As part of their integrative learning, they have also gained an understanding into the importance of the skeleton in supporting the body.

A practical activity on building up the Human Skeleton was planned as part of the learning process so that the students may become more familiar with the different parts of the skeleton in an interactive way. They had to employ the skills of listening, measuring, logical thinking, constructing and mostly, group work, to measure out and combine the main bones which make up a human skeleton, all from disposable plates. They worked co-operatively within groups and a lot of fun was had as they measured hands and feet and added their own detail to their skeletons. They quickly grasped the skill of connecting the different parts with cable tires and were excited to display their final products.

They also learnt that microscopes are used to examine and learn more about the different components which make up the Human Body. They went to the Science Lab to have their own viewing of bone pieces underneath a microscope.

They will be demonstrating and sharing some of their knowledge with the school during an assembly performance.

Science books are available in the library where the students are allowed to read at the allocated time.









Theme: To See The Plant Cell

Grade 5 students applied what they have been learning in Science about seeds and plants. They carried out several investigations and performed some presentations and experiments. Grade 5 Blue students showed the absorption process, by which seeds and plants absorb the needed water for their growth in a practical way, they used this physical property to colour some white flowers with different colours. They placed the white flowers in coloured water and waited for a period of time, the result was a very beautiful bunch of colourful flowers.

Another group of grade 5 Blue, released their imagination and asked some questions then tried to find the answers through some practical investigations. Some of their questions where ' What would be the effect of soda on the plant growth if the plant absorbed soda instead of water?, Will the colour intensity of the flower change if the absorption time change? and How will seeds germinate in different environments?'

Grade 5 Green students performed some powerpoint presentations and run class discussions that showed their interest in searching for extra informations.

Some of their projects where a small sample of a plant planted in a CD container

to watch the root and the shoot growth and another sample of different flowers planted in a box to study the differences between flowers and the flower parts.

Some of my caring students were concerned in studying seeds, they germinated different types of seeds and watched them growing to new beautiful seedlings.

As their Science teacher, I am proud of each one of them.
